

# Marriage Act

## Marriage Act Fees Regulation

[includes amendments up to B. C. Reg. 101/98]

### Interpretation

1 In this regulation,

"Act" means the *Marriage Act*.

### Fees

2 The following fees are payable under the Act:

(a) for a marriage licence (section 15).....	\$100
(b) for solemnization of a marriage (section 20).....	\$75
(c) to lodge a caveat (section 23).....	\$25

### Commission — issuer of marriage licences

3 An issuer of marriage licences who is not a salaried member of the public service is entitled to receive \$10 as commission for each marriage licence issued.

### Commission — marriage commissioner

4 A marriage commissioner who is not an employee as defined in the *Public Service Act* is entitled to receive \$50 as commission for each civil marriage ceremony performed.
